Piping - Playing Requirements

1. Events 1 - Two parts March tempo of any time signature
2. Events 2 - Slow Air & Two parts March tempo
3. Events 3 – 4 Parts March - 2/4
4. Events 4 & 5 – Minimum of 4 parts each
5. Events 7 & 8 – Own Choice

Piping - Rules

1. Competitors will only be allowed to compete in their own age group. Age will be that on the day of the actual competition.
2. Entries are open to all players 18 years and under with the exception of event 10.
3. No geographical restrictions apply.
4. Events 1 is confined to players who are not experienced performers and have not won 1st place in a Chanter competition prior to 24/02/2018. They may not play in any other piping class.
5. Event 2 is confined to players who have not been placed 1st in a Novice piping competition prior to 24/02/2018. They may not play in any other piping class.
6. Event 3 is for competitors who have graduated from Novice class, they may also play in Events 4/5 & 10/11(dependant on Age), but they may not play in any other piping class.
7. Competitors in piping classes will be allowed a maximum of 2 minutes tuning time on floor.
8. All trophies must be signed for and returned 1 month prior to competition unless by prior arrangement with the committee. Failure to return trophies in time may result in competitors being excluded from competition.
9. The judge's decisions are final.
10. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for loss or damage to any property belonging to the competitors or members of the public.
11. For all events played on the bagpipe, competitors should be in highland dress including jacket or waistcoat, tie, bonnet or Glengarry and appropriate footwear. These should be also worn for the prize giving.
12. Competitors must be ready to compete at the time directed by the stewards.
13. Tuning rooms and grounds are to be kept tidy at all times.
14. All competitors must agree to be bound by these rules and entry requirements.

Drumming - Playing Requirements

1. Events 12 - Two parts March tempo of any time signature
2. Events 13, 14, 16 & 17 - Four parts March tempo of any time signature
3. Event 15 & 18 – Min. of 4 parts each

Drumming - Rules

15. Competitors will only be allowed to compete in their own age group.
16. Age will be that on the day of the actual competition.
17. No geographical restrictions apply.
18. Events 12 is confined to players who are not experienced performers and have not won 1st place in a Pad competition or competed with a pipe band in competition prior to 24/02/2018, They may also play in event 13.
19. Event 13 is confined to players who have not been placed 1st in a Novice drumming competition prior to 24/02/2018. They may not play in any other snare drumming class.
20. Event 14 is for competitors who have graduated from Novice class. They may not play in any other Snare drumming class.
21. 1 or 2 Pipers should accompany competitors in Events 13, 14 & 15.
22. Competitors in Events 16, 17 & 18 should be accompanied by 1 or 2 Pipers and 1 Snare Drummer.
23. Competitors in event 16 may play in Event 17.
24. Competitors in event 17 may play in Event 18.
25. All trophies must be signed for and returned 1 month prior to competition unless by prior arrangement with the committee. Failure to return trophies in time may result in competitors being excluded from competition.
26. The judge's decisions are final.
27. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for loss or damage to any property belonging to the competitors or members of the public
28. For all events played on the Drum, competitors should be in highland dress including jacket or waistcoat, tie, bonnet or Glengarry and appropriate footwear if issued. These should be also worn for the prize giving.
29. Competitors must be ready to compete at the time directed by the stewards.
30. Tuning rooms and grounds are to be kept tidy at all times.
31. All competitors must agree to be bound by these rules and entry requirements.
